ICCMG2 at a glance

Metagenomics, based on next-generation sequencing (NGS) is now widely used for research purposes, and now being considered for clinical purposes.

In this context, we held the first International Conference on Clinical Metagenomics (ICCMg) in October 13-14, 2016 in Geneva, which was a remarkable success with more than 150 attendees from more than 20 countries, and a very high quality scientific program. The main messages from the first ICCMg have recently been published in the *Microbe and Infections* journal.

Hence, ICCMg is intended to be organized on a yearly basis.

For ICCMg2, we aim at keeping a high quality program with keynotes given by the current leaders in clinical metagenomics, but also to open slots for oral presentations to selected abstracts. Consequently, ICCMg2 will start earlier and will include more presentations.

Also, we feel that the translation of clinical metagenomics to the routine clinical setting is a major challenge that needs to be addressed, and we will have a dedicated session about how to tackle quality issues with speakers from regulatory agencies, private companies and the academic field.

Besides and based on the feedback of the ICCMg1 audience, we will keep the introductory session to metagenomics, practical applications of metagenomics in specific clinical situations and to the microbiota, and the issue of antimicrobial resistance.
